According to the Committee guidelines, each team should consist of one third new community members, one third somewhat experienced members, and one third experienced members. This requirement allows the Community to allow opportunities for all of it's members to serve on an Emmaus team and also to build up leaders within the community through progressive service.

Even if you have a volunteer sheet on file you may need to submit another one if; you haven't submitted a volunteer sheet in the last year, you've worked a walk recently, or you have changed your contact information.
